+ Sign of the Cross.

Lord have mercy on me, a sinner.

I keep calling out to You, My Love, Who saves me and is Savior of the World.

The Lord's acts of mercy are not exhausted, the Divine Compassion is not spent; They are renewed each morning—great is your faithfulness! (3:21-23)"

On this day of prayer, as the sun will set in Israel and Palestine and all over the world, I pray for the peace You give, O Lord.

God of mercy and compassion, of grace and reconciliation, pour your power upon all your children in the Middle East: Jews, Muslims, and Christians, Palestinians and Israelis.

Let hatred be turned into love, fear to trust, despair to hope, oppression to freedom, occupation to liberation, that violent encounters may be replaced by loving embraces, and peace and justice could be experienced by all".
